Children decorate two paper dolls in their own image- one to keep and one to donate for display at a local business. Providers can make a sign identifying their center/program which is displayed with your paper dolls, and the enclosed WOYC sign.

You may already have a parent whose child attends your center who works or owns a local business that would like to display your dolls. If you are a bigger center maybe you could split your dolls up by classroom and display them at multiple businesses.

The goal is to locally promote young children for the month of April.

April is also Child Abuse Prevention month.

Instructions:

- Make copies of the Paper Doll template (2 dolls per child; one to keep, one to display) - template below.
- If your program has difficulty making copies, please feel free to contact Rachele at Childcaring, Inc.
- Have the child cut out the doll and decorate, including their first name.
- Arrange to have a business display your dolls, the WOYC sign (template below), and a sign with your program's name.
- Deliver the dolls to businesses before April 1st; to be displayed until April 30th.
