Subject: All regulated child care programs are encouraged to apply to receive monthly payments through the Child Care Counts Payment Program. Applications Due: Nov. 19

Early Childhood Professionals:

The Department of Children and Families (DCF) is launching an updated *Child Care Counts: Stabilization Payment Program* to support Wisconsin's early care and education community. Regulated child care providers will be eligible to receive **monthly payments** through 2023, providing the financial stability they need to stay open, to recruit and retain qualified staff, and to continue providing high-quality care for children.

Applications for the new program opened on Monday, November 8, 2021 and close on Friday, November 19, 2021 at 11:59 p.m., with opportunities for new programs to apply for in future months. A total of \$351 million in funds will be available over the next 18 months and will be distributed through these two programs targeting the challenges early care and education providers are facing:

Payment Program A – Increasing Access to High-Quality Care: This payment program is intended to ensure high-quality care is available across the state by supporting the costs to remain in regulatory compliance, enhance health and safety practices, and promote continuous quality improvement with engagement in the YoungStar Quality Rating and Improvement System.
