

Eligibility Guidelines

The information below are simply guidelines and each application is reviewed on a case-by-case basis.



Families must reside in one of the following areas:

- Marathon County or Portage County.
- Marshfield area including Arpin, Auburndale, Chili, Granton, Greenwood, Loyal, Neillsville, Pittsville, Spencer, or Stratford.
- Wisconsin Rapids area including Babcock, Nekoosa, Port Edwards, Rudolph, or Vesper.

Families gross monthly/yearly income must be below 300% of the federal poverty level (see below)
