A blended model is a mix of face to face sessions (15 hours) and web-based work (35 hours) completed outside of class time through ECE Explorer (CCR&R Network Learning Management System).



This training provides foundational knowledge and skills for individuals as they begin a career in caring for children. Content includes exploring a variety of early care and education settings, including group and family child care. Learners explore rules and regulations governing child care and the responsibilities of early care and education professionals. Practices and strategies will be explored to reflect the diverse needs of children and families in Wisconsin.

This 50 hour course fulfills introductory noncredit course requirements as specified in DCF Chapters 202, 250, and 251 for Family and Group Child Care.
